



Bullying Policy

Saint Charles School has a strict No Bullying Policy. We are committed to providing all students with a safe learning environment that is free from bullying and cyber bullying.

“Bullying” is the repeated pattern of behavior overtime of unwanted, negative actions that involve an imbalance of power or strength. “Cyber Bullying” is bullying through the use of technology and/or any electronic communication device.

All students, along with their parents, are required at the start of each school year to sign the Parent/Student handbook. Stated within the Saint Charles School Handbook are guidelines for the expected behavior of our students. These guidelines will help to make our school a safe orderly place where learning can take place.

Instances of bullying may be reported in either oral or written form. Reports may be made to the classroom teacher or to the principal. Bullying Reporting Forms are available in the school office.
